1. GENERAL RULES

- 1.1 The overall speed limit outside the race track is 30 km/h and the speed limit in the paddock area is 20 km/h.
- 1.2 In any way dangerously behaving participants and drivers of other vehicles present and participants team members may be disqualified from the competition and/or be physical removed from the competition area.
- 1.3 Alcohol- or drugs-consuming is prohibited during the competition. Participants and their crew members (mechanics, other assistants) who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs can not be in the competition area and must leave the competition area (including the paddock area) at the first request of the judge or organizer.
- 1.4 All participants are obliged throughout the competition follow the rules of procedure and common good behavioral practices.

2. Paddock

- 2.1 In the paddock, maneuvering is guided by the rule of the right hand.
- 2.2 Participant is obligated to keep a fire extinguisher in a visible place. The fire extinguisher must have been checked. The fire extinguisher must have a corresponding sticker to prove that it has passed the check.
- 2.3 There must be a mat under the whole car, extending from the front bumper to the rear bumper.
- 2.4 All mechanics working in the area, defined as a paddock, must be dressed appropriately throughout the competition (long-legged pants, closed shoes and reflective vest to move in the "hot zone")
- 2.4 All the waste produced during the competition in the paddock area, must be collected into a one sealable garbage bag and taken with you or left in a visible place for the organizers.
- 2.5 Hazardous waste may not be left to the paddock. It must be taken with you when you leave and put in hazardous waste collection containers
- 2.6 In the paddock is not allowed to use coal and/or gas grill. Only electric grills are allowed.
- 2.7 In the paddock smoking (including an e-cigarette) is prohibited .

3. PENALTIES

- 3.1 Competitors may be penalized in the following cases:
 - 3.1.1 The competitor ignores and does not comply with the terms of the competition instructions/rules
 - 3.1.2 The competitor ignores the remarks and warnings of the judges or competition officials
 - 3.1.3 Unsportsmanlike behavior and/or creating a dangerous situation
 - 3.1.4 Not complying to the speed limits established outside the race track
 - 3.1.5 Doing a burnout outside the designated area.
 - 3.1.6 The competitor has used drugs or alcohol. The allowed level of alcohol concentration in breathalyzer test is 0.0.
 - 3.1.7 Competitor and / or crew members is/are using a psychotropic substances and/or is/are smoking in the paddock.
 - 3.1.8 For smoking in a race car, it is an immediate disqualification of a competitor
 - 3.1.9 There is no oil mat under the car or it doesn't reach from the front bumper to the rear bumper
 - 3.1.9 If any fluids(oil,brakefluid, coolant etc) from the race car are spilled on the tarmac on the race track or in the paddock area, and the car does not have a oil trap under the engine, and if the happens more than once during the competition, the competitor is required to pay a fine.
 - 3.1.10 If an open fire is used in the paddock.
 - 3.1.11 If there are holes drilled in to the asphalt in paddock
- 3.2 Penalty can be:
 - 3.2.1 Warning
 - 3.2.2 Financial penalty, amount 50 EUR
 - 3.2.3 Immediate disqualification
 - 3.2.4 Repeated violation, disqualification
 - 3.2.5 Competition prohibition, suspension of competitors license
 - 3.2.6 Other penalties which are set in the rulebook of the Estonian Drift Championship 2019 season
 - 3.2.7 The decision to punish a competitor is made by the Head Judge, approved by the Head Judge or the Evaluators, if necessary, the Estonian Drift Union Committee
 - 3.2.8 Penalty is determined by the Head Judge, confirmed by the Organizer, and the penalty depends on the nature of the of the violation and the consequences of the case
- 3.3 The competitor will not be able to continue the competition until the penalty has been paid
